What is a Charter School?

Charter schools are tuition-free PUBLIC schools that have more freedom to design classrooms that meet their students' needs.

Do charter schools in Alabama have to follow the same laws as traditional public schools?

Charter schools in Alabama are public schools, which means they must follow the same state and federal laws as traditional public schools, including those that protect student rights.

Do charter schools have selective admissions requirements?

Charter schools cannot discriminate in admissions, select students based on test scores or academic history, or deny access to students with disabilities.
